Executive Summary

Australia's agriculture sector is targeting \$100 billion in farm gate output by 2030, but achieving this goal requires a strong, skilled workforce. The sector faces an ageing demographic, workforce shortages, and low awareness among young people of careers in agriculture.

AgCAREERSTART is the only national program designed to provide a structured pathway for young Australians into agriculture. The program is delivered by the National Farmers' Federation (NFF) and funded by industry partners in conjunction with the Commonwealth Government Department of Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry. **AgCAREERSTART** offers an immersive, supported on-farm experience complemented by training, networking, and career development opportunities.

We are now seeking partners to co-invest in the next phase of **AgCAREERSTART** to secure the agricultural workforce pipeline and strengthen regional and rural communities.
